It appears the ANKC and Victoria Dogs & the Irish wolfhound club of Victoria all seem to think that this type of breeding, i.e. the deliberate registering of false records is an acceptable way of running a pedigree dog register. I applaud the action of the NZKC of refusing to register any Australian import IWs with blanks in the pedigree.

The Irish Wolfhound Club of NZ will also advise any prospective puppy owners of the need to be aware of the problems of buying a pup from a kennel in Aust which will not be able to be shown or registered in NZ.

It is a shame that a small group can cause such a big problem. I applaud the efforts the IW people in Australia and the International world of IWs to try and bring some semblance of responsibility to the Australian Kennel Club, Victoria Dogs, & the IW club of Victoria.
